
Parish Residents:

If you have a citrus tree on your property, the Plaquemines Parish Government is urging you to allow us to treat your trees with a safe pesticide for free. The pesticide will help reduce the population of the Asian Citrus Psyllid (ACP) found in our area.

Population reduction of the ACP will prevent the introduction of Citrus Greening Disease. Thus far, it has not been found in our Parish, but all efforts will be made to keep the disease from appearing. This disease kills citrus trees and eliminates fruit production.

**If you have had your trees treated last year, then there is no need to send us any more information. We'll continue to treat your trees beginning the first week of October. If your trees were never treated, please complete and send the bottom portion of this letter to any of the offices below. Also, if your trees were treated last year, yet elect not to continue the treatment, please let us know.**
