

An Ordinance authorizing the Port Executive Director to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement on behalf of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal District with Plaquemines Parish Government to share in the cost and benefits associated with hiring a Communications Director; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto. DIGEST: Both the Plaquemines Parish Government (PPG) and the Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal District (PPHTD) need a Communications Director to draft messaging and disseminate information to interested parties.
