The Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance were dispensed with.

President Lepine and Charter Directors Crystal Taylor, Todd Eppley and Scott Rousselle were present representing the Administration.

There being no matters under Agenda Item 2, “Executive Session”, Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 3a, “Proclamation”. Without objection, so ordered.

On motion of Council Member Cognevich, with a unanimous second, and all members present and voting “YES”, except for Council Member Arbourgh who was “ABSENT”, a Proclamation declaring March 2021 as “American Red Cross Month” in the Parish of Plaquemines was adopted by a vote of 8-0.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 9e. Without objection, so ordered.

RESOLUTION NO. 21-75

On motion of Council Member Cognevich, seconded by Council Member Rousselle, and on roll all members present and voting “YES”, except Council Member Arbourgh who was “ABSENT”, the following Resolution was adopted:

A Resolution giving supplemental approval to the issuance of not to exceed Seventy-Five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000) aggregate principal amount of Revenue Refunding Bonds of the Parish of Plaquemines, State of Louisiana, for the purpose of adding additional or alternative security to the proposed bonds and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Parish Council (the "Parish Council"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Plaquemines, State of Louisiana (the "Issuer"), by resolution adopted on May 28, 2020 (the "Prior Resolution"), authorized the preliminary approval of not exceeding \$75,000,000 of Revenue Refunding Bonds of the Issuer (the "Refunding Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the Prior Resolution permitted the Refunding Bonds to be secured by a pledge of all revenues of the Issuer, to the extent legally available for the payment of debt service on the Refunding Bonds; and

WHEREAS, this Parish Council now desires to permit a portion of the Refunding Bonds to be secured in addition or in the alternative by a direct pledge of the one percent (1%) sales and use tax now being levied and collected by the Issuer (the "Tax") pursuant to Article VI, Section 29 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and other constitutional and statutory authority, said tax being authorized by an election held therein on October 29, 1977, on a parity with the Issuer's outstanding (i) Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2014, (ii) Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2015 and (iii) Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2020 (collectively, the "Outstanding Bonds");

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL (the "Governing Authority"), THAT:

1. SECTION 1. Supplemental Approval of Refunding

Bonds. There is hereby authorized the issuance, in one or more series, of not exceeding \$32,500,000 aggregate principal amount of the Refunding Bonds to be secured by a direct pledge of the Tax and/or a pledge of all revenues of the Issuer,

to the extent legally available for the payment of debt service on the Refunding Bonds. Such portion of the Refunding Bonds shall be issued for the purpose of refunding the Refunded Obligations as defined in the Prior Resolution and have such other terms as set forth in the Prior Resolution.

2. SECTION 2. Effective Date; Repealing Clause. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The authorization contained herein shall not adversely effect the prior approval of the Refunding Bonds and shall only be construed to provide additional authorization to the extent necessary. All other resolutions of this Parish Council, including the Prior Resolution, shall remain in full force and effect except as expressly amended or supplemented hereby.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 11b(2): Rostan presentation regarding FEMA claims.” Without objection, so ordered.

Jamie Welsh and Carlos Arredondo with Rostan Solutions gave a presentation on the status of updates regarding reimbursement from FEMA on various Tropical Storms, Hurricanes and COVID between 2017 and 2020. Ms. Welsh provided a handout listing the events they are working on. Management costs are reimbursable, however, there are items that are ineligible for reimbursement. Rennie Buras, Parish Attorney, stated that the Administration is looking to have Rostan provide quarterly updates to the Council.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 11e(2), “Presentation by Andy Nyman from LSU regarding National Estuarine Research Reserve for Louisiana. Mr. Nyman, Professor at LSU was invited to serve on the committee that is trying to bring a National Estuarine Research to Louisiana. NOAA will provide up to \$5 million in funding. Up to 70% of actual costs is to support research and monitoring. He said it is a 3 to 5 year process and they are just starting. A potential site is near the water treatment plant by the ferry and syphon and is about 40 miles from New Orleans. The Parish can pick the location on Parish property. This would bring tourists and students to the area and provides the Parish a great opportunity. The Parish needs to decide if they want to pursue this opportunity. Then a state agency or university needs to fund some of the expenses and go after federal money to pay for it. Council Member Guey asked if access

was a criteria and Mr. Nyman said it isn't explicitly mentioned but should be easy to get to. The Parish can have representatives on the committee. Council Member Guey stated that because of the diversity of the Parish, we can provide a great opportunity and a better place due to where we are located. He also said that he would hope that Mr. Lepine would appoint someone from his Administration and we have members on the Council who live in the area and would be excellent because they live in those areas and have firsthand knowledge. Council Member LaFrance asked if Port Eads would be a good location but Mr. Nyman said that it is too far.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 11d; "District 1 Update". Without objection, so ordered. Council Member Barthelemy thanked President Lepine, the Director, Supervisor and commended the Solid Waste South group who was outstanding in cleaning up the East Bank. He asked the Administration to provide him with an update on the overlaying of Highway 15 and an update on the back levee from Phoenix to Bohemia. Can we possibly get a small levee from Phoenix to White Ditch where it always floods and would be glad to introduce legislation.

Council Member Barthelemy left the meeting at 6:08 p.m.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 11e(1): "Update by the Parish President and Health Department on the Coronavirus in the Parish." Without objection, so ordered. President Lepine said that he has that information in his update and asked if he would like him to proceed to it now. Council Member LaFrance asked that he do so.

Agenda Item 4, "Status Report by the Parish President". Without objection, so ordered:

The following was reported by President Lepine:

- COVID UPDATE: 1,749 confirmed cases; 2,389 probable possible cases and a positivity rate of 9.0%; and a death total of 25 including 1 probable. There have not been any deaths in February.
- VACCINE UPDATE: 4,054 people or 17.6% of residents received their initial vaccine and 2,351 of our residents (10.2%) completed the series of the vaccine.
- VACCINE SITES: Delta Drugs, Plaquemines Primary Care, Plaquemines Health Department and Plaquemines Medical Center and are only giving the second vaccine right now. 450 vaccines were given to Plaquemines Medical Center so a robo call went out today and will start administering them on Monday and are by appointment only. They will be out at the Buras Auditorium and will be assisted by the National Guard.
- Hogs for a Cause will be coming here on the grounds on June 4th and 5th. They presented a COVID plan to the LDH and our Health Department and all entities have signed off on them. We look forward to having a safe and successful event. Tickets are on sale now.
- He provided the Council Members with a form showing that we will be getting a \$700,000 grant from DOTD for streets that they will be working on. We will be cleaning up streets to prepare for the signage and stripping to be done. Council Member Cognevich asked if Venice River Road was on the list and President Lepine said he would check to see if they can do that road also.
- Gave pumpstation report last week to review and asked Dannie Spears, Pumpstation Supervisor to report and answer any questions. The handout reflected the major locations that needed to be addressed before hurricane season. Some of the stations have zero capacity and some are down with zero percent functioning. Council Member Guey asked if some of the reimbursement dollars Rostan talked about could be used for some of these locations? President Lepine asked Council Member Cognevich to introduce an ordinance to repair these locations and concentrate on the most severe stations such as Duvic, Bellevue and Pointe Celeste being the worst and that they are in different districts.

Questions and comments were made by Council Members as follows:

- Council Member Blink asked Mr. Helmers, Director of Coastal Zone if we knew a total cost to fix the levee system and pumping system? Mr. Helmers said a study was done in 2012 from the State with the costs and covers all the operations and will help maintain the levees and pumpstations. Overall we need \$6-8 million a year to maintain. A more detailed report will be coming. Council Member Blink asked Mr. Helmers if he had a cost to repair the Ollie Pumping Station. Mr. Spears responded and said it depends on if the pipe is broken or

damaged and would need to get a diver down to assess it. Council Member Blink said that he has some funds in his budget that he may be able to put towards the repairs.

- Council Member Rousselle said that following along Dr. Guey's line of thinking of putting FEMA funds back into a fund. He asked if these reimbursements and COVID money were used to balance the budget this year? President Lepine said that some were and some was put back into the emergency fund. He said that we will be getting more money from the Feds and that we may be able to move some of that money towards the pump stations. Council Member Rousselle asked if that was the money in the bill that was just passed and said that sewer and water was listed in the bill. President Lepine said he was talking about future money that would become available. Council Member Rousselle said that there were discussions recently regarding the water booster station and asked if money would be used for it and President Lepine said that he was aware of it and would do all he can to assist.
- Council Member LaFrance asked Mr. Spears about the project at the Pointe Celeste pumping station and what was all that construction about. Mr. Spears said that the Corps paid to put protection there with a concrete wall and hooked all the equipment to our pump station. He said that after Katrina, the Corps gave some motors to us so we can use them on these pump stations. We would have to pay for them to be installed. Mr. Spears also said that some of the gear boxes are replaced with better ones. Council Member LaFrance asked if the Port reached out to them about running and maintaining the Pointe Celeste Station? Mr. Spears said they asked to keep the canal at a lower level. Council Member LaFrance asked him did he seek financial help from the Port and Mr. Spears said no he hasn't. Council Member Rousselle said that we may need to create a Drainage District in the Port Complex Area and be able to assess these fees in the Omni Port Complex and assess some drainage costs to the area.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 4a, "Update by Charter Directors". Without objection so ordered. Questions were asked about the below topics:

- Council Member LaFrance said he was still waiting for Director Rousselle to advise him about the garbage truck. Director Rousselle apologized that he forgot to send him the email. He said that it is running now and that there is a new truck ordered for Solid Waste South.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 5, "Bids and Advertisements". There are none; Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 6, "Beer and Liquor Licenses". Without objection, so ordered.

Council Member Cognevich seconded the motion to adopt the Ordinance.

Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 11, "New Business". Without objection, so ordered.

There were no matters under 11a, "Resolutions wherein suspension is being sought".

Under Agenda Item 11b, "District 9 update", Council Member Cognevich stated that he has had complaints from residents daily that raw sewerage were in their yards. Director Eppley said that he would go down there to investigate and send his findings to Inframark. Council Member Cognevich also said that he was receiving calls from numerous residents that their water bills were \$300-500. He stated that one resident had an issue with the Water Department when he went to pay his February/March bill. They told him that he had not paid January yet and the resident had to go home and get the paid slip showing that he paid January. The water department said they didn't know where it went but that they would put it towards February/March. They then blamed the Council for all of their problems. Director Eppley apologized and said that he would look at these on an individual basis and could be a mistake on who read the meter. Director Eppley asked Council Member Cognevich to forward those complaints on to him and he would check them out.

There being no further business to come before this Council, on motion Council Member LaFrance, seconded by Council Member Newberry, and on roll call all members present voting "YES" except Council Members Barthelemy, Arbourgh and Blink who were "ABSENT", the meeting adjourned at 7:00p.m.
