



## **CIVIC DRIVE FISHING PIER (17-07-01) Addendum No. 3 – Summary of Revisions**

### **CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS**

1. Pages 5 and 6 – Removed Solar Lighting from contract drawings.
2. Page 16 – Removed Lighting Base Connection detail from contract drawings

### **SPECIFICATIONS**

1. BID ITEM 009 – Remove Solar Powered Lighting System from contract bid. Due to budget issues, solar lighting will not be included in the contract bid.
2. TS-Solar Powered Lighting System – Remove entire specification section.
3. Instructions to Bidders - C(5) should be amended as follows:

SALES TAXES. PPG is exempt from paying sales taxes under LSA-R.S. 47:301(8)(c). Contractor and subcontractors may be named as Contractor-Agents of the Parish. Such designation shall be effective for purchase of component construction materials, taxable services and leases and rentals of tangible personal project, as allowed by the Louisiana Department of Revenue, only for the Construction Project and Contract Number identified on the Designation of Construction Contractor as Agent of a Governmental Entity Sales Tax Exemption Certificate, prepared for the Project. The contractor-agent is not authorized to delegate its purchasing agency to others. Separate designations of agency by PPG are required for each contractor or sub-contractor. All designations shall comply with applicable law.

4. Section 00100 Advertisement of Bids – Bid Opening shall be revised as follows:

The sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 10:00 a.m. on the 18th day of February 2020, in the Conference Room at the Plaquemines Parish Engineering Office located at 333 F. Edward Hebert Blvd., Building 500, Belle Chasse, Louisiana 70037.

Contractors submitting bids shall be licensed under LA License R.S. 37:2150-2164, with the following classification: General Construction. Other license classifications may, at the option of the Owner, be considered based upon a thorough review of the Contractor's past experience. The bidder shall show his license number on the bid and on the sealed envelope submitting the bid.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids for just cause; such actions will be in accordance with Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes.

In accordance with R.S. 38:2212 (B)(1), the provisions and requirements stated in the Advertisement for Bids and those required on the Bid Form shall not be considered as informalities and shall not be waived. In accordance with LA R.S. 38:2214.C, bidders may withdraw bids prior to bids being opened.

Each Bidder must deposit with his/her bid, security in the amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid price, provided on the specified form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. Sureties used for obtaining bonds must appear as acceptable on the U. S. Department of Treasury Circular 570.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Any person with disabilities requiring special accommodations must contact the Parish of Plaquemines no later than seven (7) days prior to bid opening.
