24           Executive Counsel

- 25           a.   The position of Executive Counsel shall be a full-time unclassified position, with all of  
26           the benefits thereof.
- 27           b.   A candidate for Executive Counsel shall hold a valid license to practice law in the State  
28           of Louisiana, and have held such license for not less than ten (10) years prior to  
29           appointment.
- 30           c.   The Executive Counsel shall be appointed by the Plaquemines Parish Council, as the Sole  
31           Governing Authority of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal District, upon the vote  
32           of majority of the members thereof. The Executive Counsel may only be terminated by  
33           the Plaquemines Parish Council as the Sole Governing Authority of the Plaquemines  
34           Port, Harbor & Terminal District, upon a majority vote thereof.
- 35           d.   The Executive Counsel shall work cooperatively with the Executive Director and other  
36           executive Port staff, but the client for all purposes shall be the Plaquemines Parish  
37           Council, as the Sole Governing Authority of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal  
38           District and the Executive Counsel shall report directly to the Port Chairperson.
- 39           e.   The Executive Counsel shall provide for the day-to-day legal services and provide legal  
40           advice to the Port, the Port staff, and the Plaquemines Parish Council, as the Sole  
41           Governing Authority of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal District.
- 42           f.   The Executive Counsel shall attend all meetings of the Plaquemines Parish Council as  
43           the Sole Governing Authority of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal District,  
44           unless otherwise excused by the Port Chairperson.

45  
46           SECTION 2

47           The Legal Department and the position of Executive Counsel shall take effect on January 1, 2022;  
48           however, this ordinance shall be immediately effective so as to provide for the direction and  
49           authorization of various activities to support that the position of Executive Counsel be filled, so as  
50           to begin on January 1, 2022.

51  
52           To facilitate the recruitment and hiring of the Executive Counsel, the Executive Director shall:

- 53           •   Communicate with the Plaquemines Parish Civil Service Department to facilitate the

- 54 creation of the unclassified position of Executive Counsel and report back to the Council  
55 in the event any additional actions are required;
- 56 • Direct Port staff to incorporate the Legal Department and the position of Executive Counsel  
57 into the proposed 2022 General Fund Budget for the Port, with a beginning salary for the  
58 position of \$125,000 per year;
  - 59 • Direct Port staff to take such efforts as are reasonable and prudent to advertise for the new  
60 position of Executive Counsel, so that the Council may consider applicants prior to the end  
61 of 2021, and to report back to the Council at each meeting as to the efforts undertaken;
  - 62 • Cause to be included in the proposed budget for 2022 funding for the Legal Department  
63 and the position of Executive Counsel.

34   legal advice to the Port staff and the Council as the sole governing authority of  
35   Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District
- 36   f.   The Executive Counsel shall attend all meetings of the Plaquemines Parish Council  
37   acting as the sole governing authority of the Port, unless otherwise excused by the  
38   Executive Director.
