**RIGHT-OF-ENTRY ONTO PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR DEBRIS REMOVAL
HURRICANE IDA DISASTER ASSISTANCE (SOE HURRICANE IDA)**

Ownership Interest, Debris Removal Request, and Grant of Right of Entry

The undersigned hereby certifies they/he/she are/is the owner(s), or lessee(s) or mortgagor(s) with authority to grant access to the property bearing municipal number: _____, and do(es) hereby request aid in removing debris which presents an immediate threat to the lives, public health and safety of the Citizens of Plaquemines Parish, and to prevent further damage to the property and authorize(s) the Parish of Plaquemines, State of Louisiana, its agents, successors and assigns and its contractors and subcontractors, the United States of America and its agents and assigns, and its contractors and subcontractors (collectively, the “Debris Removal Parties”), to have the right of access and to enter in and onto the property for the purpose of removing and clearing any or all Hurricane Ida-generated debris of whatever nature from the above described property.

Removal of All Non-Dwelling Debris

If there is vegetative, construction and demolition waste, white goods and other miscellaneous debris (except motor vehicles) that is to be removed on private property:

- I/We expressly give permission to the Debris Removal Parties remove the vegetative, construction and demolition waste, white goods and other miscellaneous debris (except motor vehicles); and
- If insured, I/we certify that the insurance adjuster has seen vegetative, construction and demolition waste, white goods and other miscellaneous debris (except motor vehicles).

Removal of Any Motor Vehicles

If there is motor vehicle debris that is to be removed on private property:

- I/We expressly give permission to the Debris Removal Parties remove any motor vehicle; and
- If insured, I/we certify that the insurance adjuster has seen the motor vehicle.

Removal of Any Dwellings and Structures

If there is a dwelling or structure that is to be removed on private property:

Government Not Obligated; No Expense Except For Insurance Proceeds

It is fully understood that this Right-of-Entry is not an obligation of the Debris Removal Parties to perform debris clearance. If determined necessary and in the public interest in accordance with federal regulations, the debris clearance will be conducted at no expense to the said property owner(s) by personnel authorized by the Plaquemines Parish Government, although insurance, reimbursement or other proceeds paid to myself/us for debris removal resulting from Hurricane Ida must be handled as set out below.

Government Indemnified and Held Harmless

Additionally, the undersigned will indemnify and hold harmless the Debris Removal Parties for any damage of any type whatsoever to the above described property or to personal property and fixtures situated thereon, or for bodily injury or death to persons on the property, and hereby releases, discharges and waives any and all actions, either legal or equitable, which the undersigned has, or ever might or may have, by reason of any action of aforesaid Debris Removal Parties taken to accomplish the aforementioned purpose.

Avoidance of Duplication of Benefits; Reporting Receipt of Money for Debris Removal

The undersigned understands and acknowledges that receipt of compensation or reimbursement, compensation for performance of the aforementioned activities from any other source, including Small Business Administration, Natural Resources Conservation Service, private insurance, an individual and family grant program or any other public assistance program could constitute a duplication of benefits prohibited by federal law. In the event any compensation from any source is received by the undersigned or any other party for performance of the aforementioned activities on this property, the undersigned will report the same to the Plaquemines Parish Government identified herein where the property is located. The undersigned will report any such compensation or reimbursement received as of this date.

The undersigned agrees to work with the PLAQUEMINES PARISH GOVERNMENT, GOHSEP, and FEMA to pursue and recover insurance proceeds applicable to this work and credit FEMA the federal share of any proceeds received.

Power and Authority to Sign Right of Entry

The undersigned represents and warrants that he/she/they has/have full power and authority to execute and fully perform the obligations under this Right-of-Entry without the need for any further action, or that he/she/they is/are duly appointed agent(s) of the owner/lessee/mortgagor, and that he/she/they has/have full power and authority to execute and fully perform the obligations under this Right-of-Entry without the need for any further action. Additionally, the undersigned is fully aware that an individual who fraudulently or willfully misstates any fact in connection with this agreement may be subject to penalties under state and federal law, including civil penalties, imprisonment for not more than five years, or both, as provided under 18 USC 1001.

Release of Insurance Information
