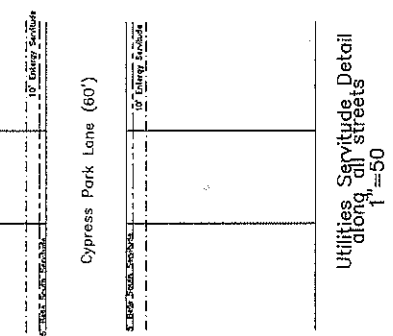

ORDINANCE NO. 20-

The following Ordinance was offered by Council Member LaFrance who moved its adoption:

1           An Ordinance, pursuant to Act 665 of the 2016 Regular Session of the Louisiana  
2           Legislature relative to Communication Districts, to levy emergency telephone  
3           service charges (911 service charges); and otherwise to provide with respect  
4           thereto.

5   WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Parish Council at its meeting held on April 14, 1988, adopted  
6   Ordinance No. 88-121 creating, pursuant to the authority of Title 33, Chapter 31, Sections 9101-  
7   9106, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes, a communications district entitled, "Plaquemines Parish  
8   Communications District" ("District"); and  
9

10   WHEREAS, on February 22 1990, the Plaquemines Parish Council acting as the governing  
11   authority of the District adopted Ordinance Number 90-24 calling an election for April 7, 1990,  
12   for the proposition of levying of a tariff rate for local telephone service supplied within each  
13   district, for the purpose of establishing, maintaining and operating the 911 Emergency Service  
14   Telephone System, provided that the service charge shall be imposed only upon the amount of the  
15   tariff rate for exchange access lines or their equivalent, of five (5%) percent of the tariff rate for  
16   local telephone service supplied within the district; and  
17

18   WHEREAS, on April 12, 1990, the Plaquemines Parish Council acting as the governing authority  
19   of the District adopted Resolution Number 90-142 providing for the canvassing the returns and  
20   declaring the results of the special election held in the Parish of Plaquemines on Saturday, April  
21   7, 1990 declaring and proclaiming that the proposition submitted to the qualified electors voting  
22   at the said special election held in the Parish on Saturday, April 7, 1990, was duly carried by a  
23   majority of the votes cast; and  
24

25   WHEREAS, on October 22, 1992, the Plaquemines Parish Council acting as the governing  
26   authority of the District adopted Ordinance No. 92-199 levying a tariff rate of fifty-five cents  
27   (\$0.55) per residence line and one-dollar-and-forty three cents (\$1.43) per business line with a  
28   maximum charge of 5 lines for local telephone service for Enhanced 911 Emergency Service  
29   Telephone System; and  
30

31   WHEREAS, since the local tariff rate has not been increased since October 22, 1992 and the  
32   District is operating at a deficit of approximately four-hundred and eighty-four thousand dollars  
33   (\$484,000) requiring a transfer from the General Fund to support its operations; and  
34

35   WHEREAS, the general fund no longer has the revenues to subsidize the District;

36   NOW, THEREFORE:

37  
38   BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL, AS AND ON BEHALF OF,  
39   AND SITTING AS THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH  
40   COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT, THAT:

SECTION 1

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42  
43   It hereby levies an emergency telephone service charge (911 service charge) to wireline residential  
44   service users of fixed location wire line (i.e., landline telephone exchange service or equivalent)  
45   within the boundaries of Plaquemines Parish in the amount of one dollar and forty-five cents  
46   (\$1.45) per access line per month.  
47

SECTION 2

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50   It hereby levies an emergency telephone service charge (911 service charge) to wireline business  
51   service users of fixed location wireline (i.e., landline telephone exchange service or equivalent)  
52   within the boundaries of Plaquemines Parish in the amount of six dollars per access line per month,  
53   not to exceed ten (10) lines per business account.  
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SECTION 3

Pursuant to Act 665 of the 2016 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature, it hereby levies an emergency telephone service charge (911 service charge) to residential service users of interconnected Voice over Internet protocol (VoIP) within the boundaries of Plaquemines Parish in the amount of \$1.45 per access line per month.

SECTION 4

Pursuant to Act 665 of the 2016 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature, it hereby levies an emergency telephone service charge (911 service charge) to business service users of interconnected Voice over Internet protocol (VoIP) within the boundaries of Plaquemines Parish in the amount of six dollars per access line per month, not to exceed ten (10) lines per business account.

SECTION 5

The District shall utilize its revenues for communication enhancements which enable public safety agencies to decrease response times and improve effectiveness and for establishing, maintaining, reporting, and operating 911 emergency telephone services.

SECTION 6

The emergency telephone service charges (911 service charges) established herein shall become effective July 1, 2020.

SECTION 7

If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 8

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9

The Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and release this Ordinance and that Parish employees and officials are authorized to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish Council.

15   Taylor, Director of Public Service, Todd Eppley, or the Plaquemines Parish Council Chairman,  
16   only if provision of Section 3.07A of Article 3 of the Plaquemines Parish Charter are made  
17   effective and are implemented as to the Council Chairman.
